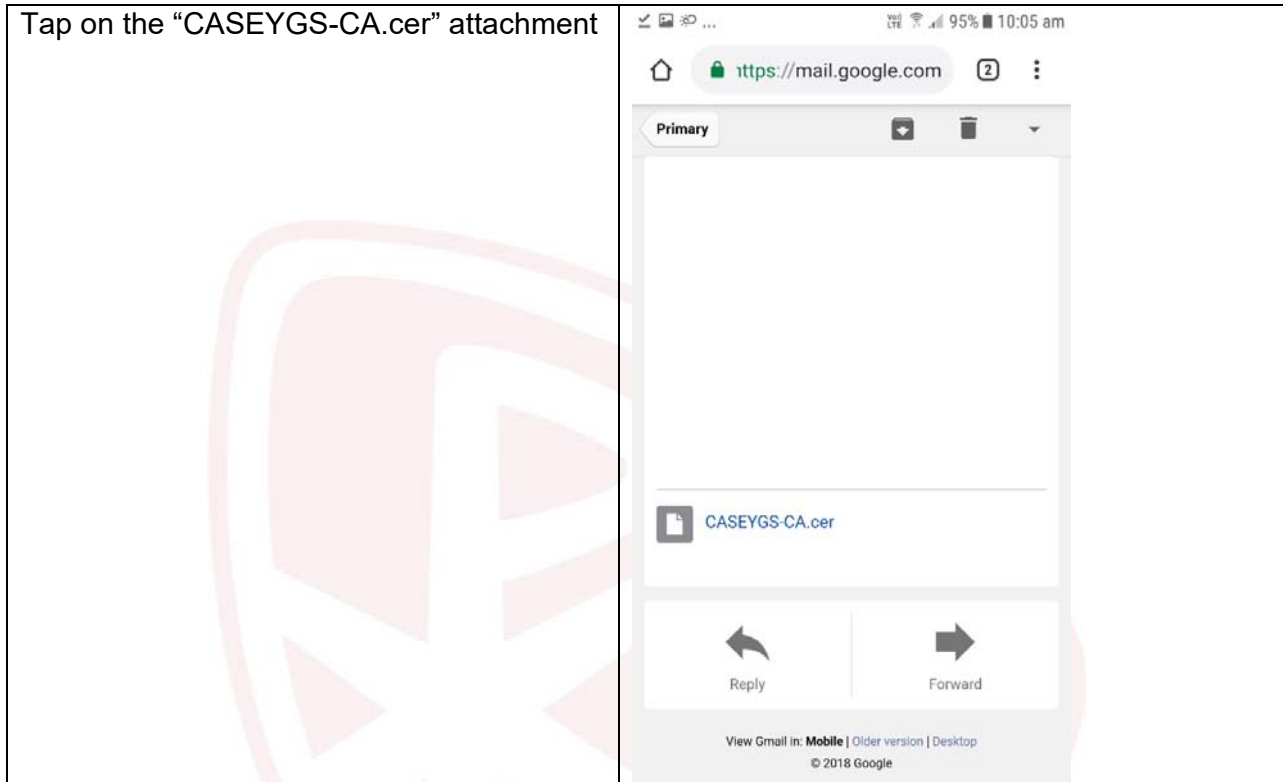


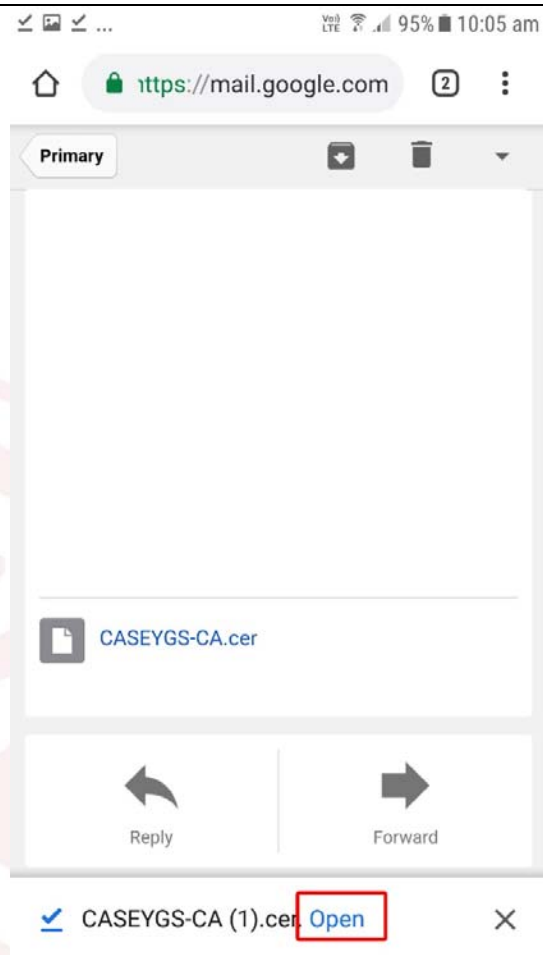

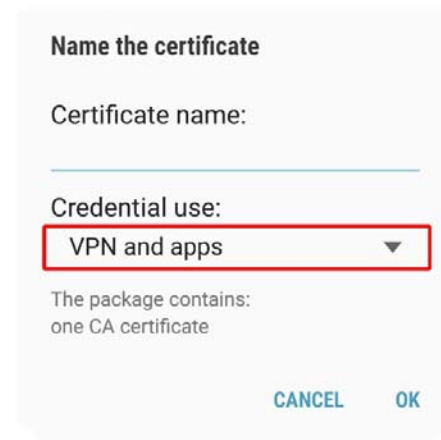

Once the attachment has downloaded select “open” from the bottom of the screen

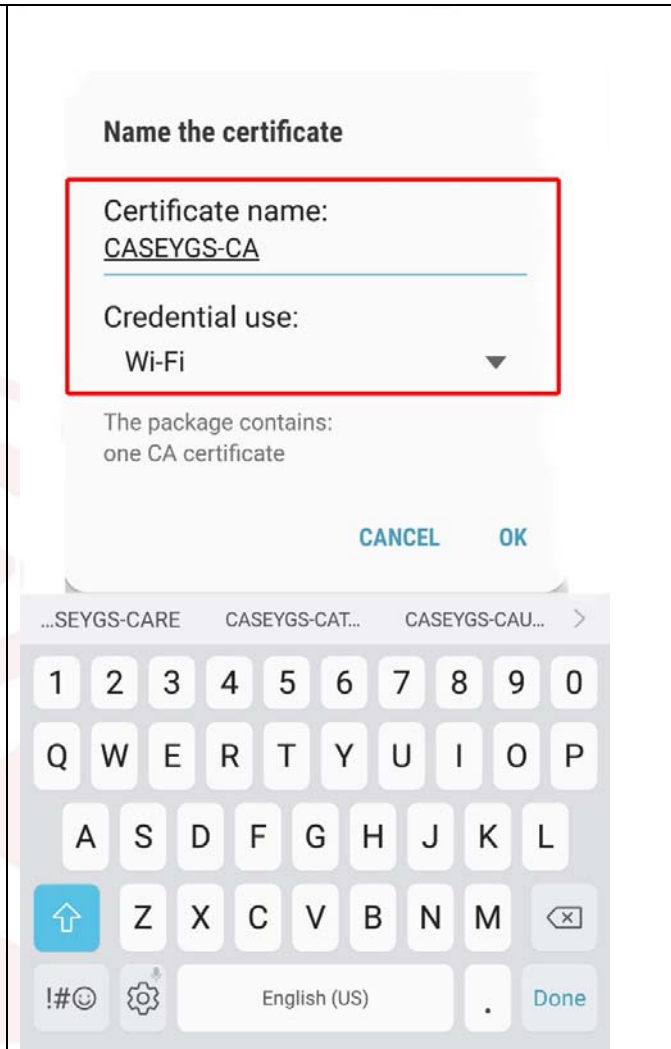


Tap on the drop down menu and select “WiFi”

Click on the hamburger menu on the top right and select options

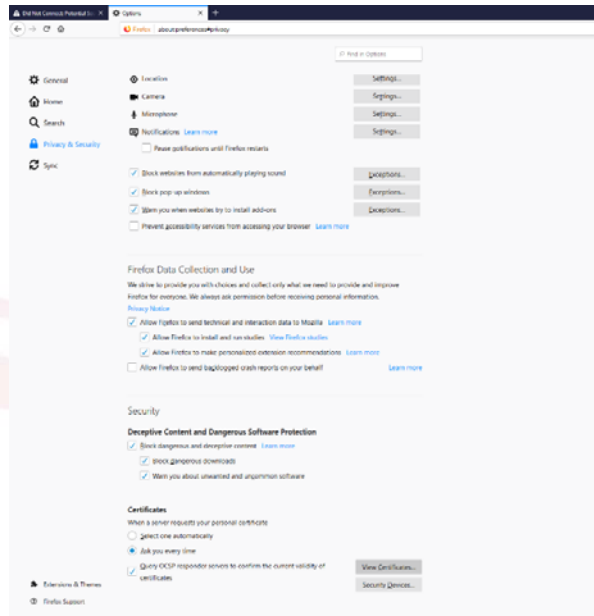


Click on privacy and security on the left

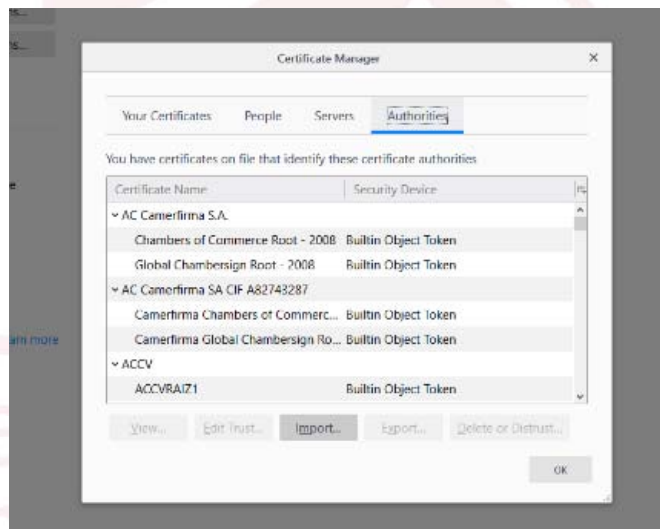

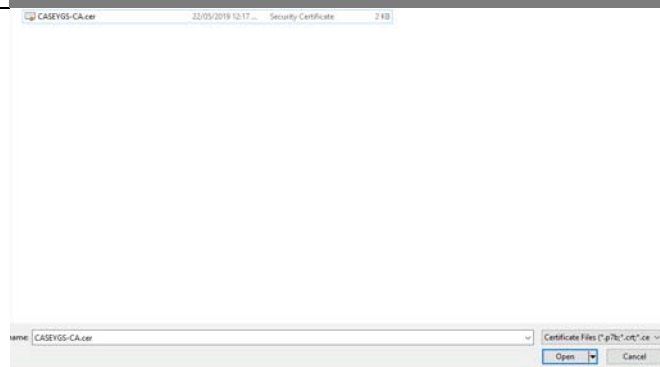


Click on import at the bottom
