Casey Grammar School is a Foundation – Year 12 Coeducational School with an open enrolment policy. We welcome families of all backgrounds who are willing to participate fully in the life of the school and are prepared to commit to the school's focus on educating every child in a holistic way consistent with the school's values and ethos.

Religious Education, Co-curricular & Wellbeing

Religious Education exploring the Christian faith is compulsory at Casey Grammar School. Co-curricular activities and camps are non-negotiable. The wellbeing of all students is a vital element of the respect and regard that everyone is called to take on.

Intake Year Levels

Casey Grammar School's current intake levels are at Foundation, and limited opportunities to enrol at the beginning of Year 11. Please note: the VCE program is a two year commitment and students are not permitted to enrol in Year 11 or Year 12 midway through the year.

What year is my child eligible to commence Foundation?

Casey Grammar School has a minimum age requirement for Foundation. Students are required to turn 5 years of age by the end of February of the year in which they commence Foundation.

The year of entry guide will help you determine the calendar year your child is eligible to commence Foundation.

When should I submit an application for enrolment?

Enrolment demands exceed the places available. We encourage prospective families to submit an application for enrolment as soon as they know Casey Grammar is your school of choice. Expressions of Interest are accepted from birth.

Are applications considered for other year levels?

Enrolment is available in other year levels when a current student leaves the school. Your application will be placed on a waiting list, but please understand that we cannot guarantee enrolment for your child, so you may need to consider alternative options. If a vacancy does not become available in the requested year level, your child's name will carry over to the waiting list for each subsequent year.

Does Casey Grammar School have enrolment priorities?

Casey Grammar applies priority to the following Applications for enrolment: siblings of current students, children of staff members, children of past students who completed their education at Casey Grammar, siblings of past students who completed their education at Casey Grammar, children from families who values and beliefs align with the School's values and Christian ethos, children who have demonstrated past high academic progress and/or high level of involvement in co-curricular activities, date of application and/or any other matter the Principal considers appropriate.

How likely is it that my child will be offered a place?

We cannot guarantee whether your child will be offered enrolment, it depends on several factors, including availability, assessment results, a satisfactory interview, our ability to provide a suitable program for the student, and acceptance of the terms and conditions of enrolment.

Are waiting lists static?

The waiting lists at Casey Grammar School are dynamic; they change regularly as children are moved from one list to another, priority students join the lists, and children's names advance into the next year level.

Contact Details

It is the responsibility of parents to notify the school of any change to email, contact address and telephone numbers. Failure to do so will result in the child's application being cancelled when undeliverable mail (including email) is returned to the school. Cancellation will also occur for the following reasons:

- a response is not received by the due date of any correspondence
- failing to attend an interview without contacting the school to make alternate arrangements
- a confirmation deposit is not paid by the due date
- an enrolment contract is not signed and returned to the school by the due date

Applications can be reinstated with an application date that will reflect the date when contact was made.

SEQTA Learn

Casey Grammar School utilises SEQTA as its learning management system. The parent portal allows you to access valuable information regarding your child, including end-of-semester reports.
